BOARD ORDER

Under the authority of section 137.1 of *The Workers' Compensation Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter W-15 (WCA), the Board of Directors of the Workers Compensation Board (WCB) hereby orders that:

Where a worker is

- under the direction of the WCB or the Appeals Commission, and
- required to travel to a place other than the place where the worker resides,


the WCB is empowered to pay a travel allowance, a subsistence allowance and a wage loss allowance, or any of them, in accordance with the policies and procedures established by the WCB, from time to time, for the payment of such allowances.

Further, under the authority of section 157 of the WCA, this Order shall have retroactive application to the extent required to give effect to payments made under those policies and procedures prior to the date of this Order.
